STREET EXCAVATION PERMIT SUMMARY OF REQUIREMENTS

Summarized herein are pertinent CITY CODE requirements governing the need for and issuance of a Street Excavation Permit. The information provided is not inclusive of all related code requirements; therefore the applicant should familiarize himself with the text of Section 48 before proceeding with any street excavation project.

A. PERMIT REQUIRED

A STREET EXCAVATION PERMIT must be obtained prior to any excavation in a street, alley, or other public right-of-way. Contractors acting as agents for the City and corporations operating under a franchise agreement which provides for such excavation are exempt from the PERMIT requirement.

B. PERMIT FEE

The fee for a STREET EXCAVATION PERMIT is twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

C. DEPOSIT REQUIRED

In addition to the permit fee a cash deposit in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) per excavation site, to ensure proper restoration and repair, shall accompany the Permit Application. Upon satisfactory restoration of excavation, the deposit will be refunded, without interest, to the permittee. If multiple excavations are involved, the applicant may post a Performance Bond in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) in lieu of individual site deposits.

D. CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

A current Certificate of Insurance should be submitted as part of the application for permit. The coverage shall be in accordance with the requirements of the city's insurance carrier; a copy of required coverage is attached to the Permit Application.

E. HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

The applicant shall submit an executed General Hold Harmless Agreement prior to the issuance of a permit.

F. BACKFILL and SURFACE RESTORATION

Ordinance 91-8 specifies the manner in which street, alley, and parkway excavations are to be backfilled and surface to be familiar with said specifications and to comply accordingly. Backfill operations are to be preceded by a minimum twenty-four (24) hour notice of backfill to City Hall. The Superintendent of Public Services, or representative, must be on site for backfill operations. Failure to comply will result in forfeiture of the deposit.

G. CHARGE to REPAIR BY CITY

If the permittee fails or neglects to comply with the provisions of Ordinance 91-8 the city shall cause necessary repairs and restorations to be made. The full cost of any such repairs shall be deducted from the permittee's cash deposit; should actual costs of repair/restoration exceed the amount of the deposit, the permittee will be responsible for all excess expenses.
