**Ordinance**

**2.88.020 Definitions.**

Unless specifically defined below, words or phrases in this ordinance shall be interpreted giving them the same meaning as they have in common usage and so as to give this ordinance its most reasonable application.

- A. Alteration - Any act or process that changes one or more of the exterior architectural, but not purely cosmetic, characteristics or interior stabilization features of a structure, including, but not limited to, the re-erection, construction, reconstruction, or removal of any part or all of a structure.

- N. Exterior Architectural Appearance - The architectural and general composition of the exterior of a structure, including, but not limited to the kind and the texture of the building material and the type, design and character of all windows, doors, light fixtures, signs, and appurtenant elements.
