The Morrison City Council met in Special Session on May 17, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in the Morrison Community Room, 307 S Madison St., Morrison, IL. Mayor Scott Vandermyde called the meeting to order. City Clerk Michael Hemmer recorded the minutes.

Aldermen present on roll call were: Mick Welding, Harvey Zuidema, Vernon Tervelt, Josh West, Kevin Bruckner, Jr. and Arlyn Deets. Absent: NONE. Vacant: Ward 1 (2 seats).

Other City officials present were City Administrator Barry Dykhuizen, Public Services Director Lori Matlack and Police Chief Brian Melton.

Items for Consideration and Possible Action


1. Alderman Welding moved to approve to replacing Alderman Deets with Police Chief Brian Melton as a signatory of the city accounts. Alderman Bruckner seconded. On a roll call vote of 4 ayes (Welding, West, Bruckner and Deets) and 2 nays (Zuidema, Tervelt) the motion carried.

Joy Tegeler (Owner, Tegeler Accounting Services - Morrison Community Preschool's accounting firm), Anne Mills (Director, Morrison Community Preschool), Kim Ewoldson (Parent of preschooler) spoke on behalf of Morrison Community Preschool renting the Community Room for one year. Butch Vander Schaff (President of Morrison Grand Squares) spoke on behalf of a group regularly using the community room. Anne Mills submitted report "Morrison Community Preschool. Organization Information & Location Search" to Council. Individual speakers answered questions from council.


