RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Permit: Initial Application Fee is \$100.00, Annual Renewal Fee is \$75, both valid for that calendar year only.
- Non-Highway Vehicles are hereinafter referred to as NHV's.
- NHV's operating within the city limits of the City of Morrison shall possess and display a current permit issued by the City of Morrison, Illinois.
- All persons must wear a seat belt while riding upon NHV. Children younger than 3 years of age must be in a child restraint and secured with a seat belt upon NHV.
- NHV's are not allowed on sidewalks, bike paths or other pedestrian trails.
- NHV's are not allowed on IL RT 78 or US RT 30, which includes portions of Cherry Street, Wall Street, Clinton Street and Portland Avenue. Such vehicles must cross these state roadways perpendicularly (in a 90° line).
- Any person operating a NHV under the influence of alcohol/drugs is subject to sections 11-500 through 11-502 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
- NHV's are subject to mandatory insurance requirements as defined in the Illinois Vehicle Code.
- NHV operators shall be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license.
- Operators and passengers shall use NHV's in a responsible and safe manner at all times.
- NHV's shall only be operated between the hours of 6:00 am and 10:00 pm.
- NHV's shall yield to overtaking vehicles.
- A headlight and tail lamp shall be lighted at all times when operating a NHV on public property.
- NHV's shall comply with the city speed limit of **25 MPH** and **golf carts** specifically, shall comply with a speed limit of **20 MPH**.
- NHV's shall comply with all other relevant traffic regulations and local ordinances.
- Any violation of the NHV ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$150.00 or no more than \$750.00 for each violation. Subsequent violations of more than 2 violations in a 12-month period shall result in the revocation of such permit.

WAIVER - Release of All Claims and Hold Harmless

By participating in the described activities and obtaining a permit under an ordinance entitled "Non-Highway Vehicles on City of Morrison Public Streets", you are waiving and releasing all claims for injuries and/or damages arising out of any and all activities during operation and use of the Non-Highway Vehicle Permit. As consideration for being issued a permit under the aforementioned ordinance, the participant understands and agrees to all rules, regulations, statements and representations set forth in this document.

1. As a participant, I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of property damage and physical injury and I agree to assume the risk of any injuries, including death, damages or loss which I may sustain as a result of participating, in any manner, in activities connected with, associated with or arising out of any activities relating to the issuance of a permit under the aforementioned ordinance, which includes but is not limited to owning, operating, riding in, or otherwise associated in any way to the operation of a non-highway vehicle as defined by the ordinance herein. I further recognize and acknowledge that the activities are hazardous and involve substantial risks of injury and/or damage.
2. I further understand and agree that the terms such as "participation", "participating" and "activities" referred to in this document, include all actions and physical movements of any nature relating or involved with a non-highway vehicle as defined in the aforementioned ordinance with a permit to operate such a vehicle on the property of the City of Morrison, or involved with the City or released parties.
3. I hereby assume full responsibility for the risk of bodily injury, death or property damage due to the negligence of any of the released parties or otherwise while in or upon City or public property and while participating in any such activities.
4. I expressly agree that this Waiver is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Illinois, and that if any portion herein is held invalid, it is understood that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

By my signature below, I hereby affirm the information I have provided to this document is true and accurate. I have also read and understand all rules, regulations, statements and representations set forth in this document which represents the City of Morrison, Whiteside County, Illinois, Municipal Code, Chapter 54, Article XII "Non-Highway Vehicles on City of Morrison Public Streets." I further understand that I am responsible for compliance to such ordinance by myself and those operating under the permit in which I am making application for.
